## ORDER SETTING DEPOSITION DATE FOR JOE BEYERS

WHEREAS, on or about April 9,2009, Advanced Micro Devices, Inc. and AMD International Sales and Service Ltd. (collectively "AMD") served a deposition subpoena for the deposition of Joe Beyers;

WHEREAS, on April 24,2009, the Special Master heard argument regarding the scheduling of the Beyers deposition; and

WHEREAS, the parties agree that Mr. Beyers is an important witness;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

1. The deposition of Joe Beyers shall proceed as scheduled on April 30 and May 1,

2009.
