**ORDER REGARDING HEWLETT-PACKARD THIRD PARTY

WHEREAS, HP witness Scott Stallard has been on extended travel outside the country and will not return until after the discovery cutoff date passes;


WHEREAS, HP witness Richard Walker was set for deposition on June 11 but an important and unavoidable business conflict has rendered him unavailable on that date;
