Not later than December 10. 2009, AMD shall serve its individualized objections to the exhibits listed in Intel's preliminary exhibit list to be served on November 16, 2009, and Intel shall serve its individualized objections to the exhibits listed in AMD's preliminary list of rebuttal exhibits to be served on December 4, 2009.
