
Dear Judge Poppiti:

We are in receipt of the Stipulation and [Proposed] Order Dismissing Sanctions Motions transmitted to Your Honor by counsel for Intel yesterday evening (the "Sanctions Stipulation"). The Sanctions Stipulation provides for the dismissal, with prejudice, of "each party's sanction motion," based on AMD's and Intel's resolution of "their disputes including those arising from the retention and production of data in this action" Although AMD and Intel are the only signatories to the Sanctions Stipulation, the stipulation was prepared with the captions for not only the AMD and multi-district actions, but also the caption for the consolidated class actions, *Paul v. Intel Corporation*, Cons. C.A. NO. 05-485-JJF. AMD and Intel apparently intend for the Sanctions Stipulation to be entered as an Order on all three dockets.

Class Plaintiffs object to the entry of the Sanctions Stipulation as an Order to the extent it would preclude us from independently challenging Intel's document and data retention and production deficiencies. We respectfully request that any Order that the Court enters dismissing AMD's and Intel's sanctions motions be without prejudice to Class Plaintiffs' right to separately seek sanctions against Intel relating to such production and retention issues.
