Dear Judge Poppiti:

Stroz Friedberg respectfully requests amendment to the "Stipulated Order of Appointment of Eric Friedberg and Stroz Friedberg LLC as Consultants to the Court" entered in the above referenced matter. In particular, we seek clarification of Paragraph 3, which governs conflicts of interest. Although that provision does not prohibit our retention in unrelated matters, it has come to our attention that individual members of one or more of the law firms involved in this litigation have expressed concern that retaining us in wholly unrelated matters may create an appearance of impropriety. Given the long duration of this case and the number of well-recognized, international law firms involved in the various aspect of this litigation, we believe such hesitation to hire Stroz could, over the long run, negatively impact or wholly negate the financial value of our retention by the Court in this matter.

Accordingly, we submit for your consideration the following explanatory language to append to Paragraph 3:

This provision bars only direct engagement of Stroz Friedberg by the Parties, as defined in footnote 2 of this Order, and shall not be deemed to prevent any individual counsel involved in this matter or their respective law firms from engaging Stroz Friedberg in any matters unrelated to this litigation. The Parties and their counsel and law firms acknowledge that retaining Stroz Friedberg on unrelated matters would not result in a conflict of interest or an appearance of impropriety. Stroz Friedberg is permitted to have normal commercial relations with all of the Parties' counsel and law firms, including retaining such law firms for Stroz Friedberg's own legal work in unrelated matters.

Please let me know how you would like to proceed regarding dissemination of this request to the Parties for their review. I would be happy to further discuss these issues with Your Honor or the Parties' counsel if need be.
