Intel® RAID Controller SASWT4I and Intel® RAID Controller SASUC8I List Incorrect Supported RAID Levels in the Feature Panel of the Individual Pack Box.

Description

Intel® RAID Controllers SASWT4I and SASUC8I individual pack box lists supported RAID levels as 0, 1, 5 and 10 in the features section on bottom of the box; however, the controller supports RAID 0, 1 and 1E RAID levels. In addition, RAID Level Migration is not supported on this product.

Root Cause

The Intel® RAID Controller Feature panel printed on the bottom side of the individual product box doesn't correctly represent the features of the Intel® RAID Controller SASWT4I and SASUC8I. The RAID controller Quick Start Guide, Hardware Guide, Technical Product Specification, and Product Brief, as well at the product description on the Intel Public Website all correctly describe the RAID levels and other features offered on these products.

Corrective Action / Resolution

- 1) Information listed in the product box feature panel will be corrected to display the correct RAID levels supported.
 - a) "RAID levels 0,1, and 5" and "RAID Span 10" will be changed to "RAID levels 0,1 and 1E"
 - b) "Online RAID Level Migration" notation will be removed.
