PC (2)	Required to have internet access and located near the server.  Supported operating systems on the client side:  Microsoft Windows XP*  Microsoft Windows Vista* or  Microsoft Windows 7*.  1st PC for management and 2 <sup>nd</sup> PC needed to connect to the remote training session.
Ethernet cables (2)	
Monitor (1)	Needs to have a DVI port or VGA to DVI adapter. Monitor to be used self activation or a guided activation. Optional for deployment.
USB keyboard (1)	Keyboard to be used for self activation or a guided activation purposes. Optional for deployment.

Identify channel or msp ID that would be used to manage the Intel Hybrid Cloud Server	Only one MSP ID or Channel account can manage the Intel Hybrid Cloud Server, once enrolled, switching to another MSP ID or Channel account is currently not possible. Server is <b>required</b> to have internet access	Place it in a location where the server can be connected to the internet via an Ethernet cable.
Setup server	<ol> <li>Connect the monitor, keyboard and power cable to the server but don't turn the server on (Monitor and keyboard used for self activation or a guided activation purposes, optional for deployment).</li> <li>Connect the ethernet cable from port A of the server to a switch, router or cable modem with internet access.</li> </ol>
	Important: Leave port B disconnected when powering up the server for the first time.
Firewall settings	Optional, only if remote management access is needed.
